




1970 ACORN Picture – 2nd Avenue House







From the beginning...."lota Chapter of Phi Kappa Tau was no accident – it was the result of the decision of a classy group of men, very conscientious and mature, who concluded that a national fraternity was the answer to what a college man should expect from belonging to a fraternity. So, in 1919, this group petitioned Phi Kappa Tau National Fraternity, headquartered in Oxford, OH, for a chapter at Coe College in Cedar Rapids, IA. The charter members of lota Chapter were a group to be proud of. I personally knew most of them. Although many of them had been graduated before I came to Coe in 1922, several of that group were then seniors in college, and one of them - Karl Roths '23, was the president of the chapter. He was as fine a man as I have ever known. At the time, the women on campus were housed in a dormitory called "Voorhees Hall". There was no men's dormitory, so the fraternities were usually housed in large old residences that once served as private family homes. The Phi Kappa Tau chapter was housed at 834 First Avenue NE. It was a large Victorian home – painted an ugly brown color. Fortunately, I was able to attend the 75th Anniversary celebration for lota Chapter in 1995 when I unexpectedly received the Borradaile Award, an honor that means so much to me. These notes were written at the request of Tom Hazelton - he has taught me a valuable lesson.....that the fraternity can enrich one's life even after graduation. I have been blessed with a long, healthy life but have lost most of my lifelong friends. The fraternity has brought me great new friends like Tom & his family and Jerry Adams '59. My best wishes to all my Brothers of lota Chapter as you celebrate our 80th year!" (Paul entered Chapter Eternal early in 2000, just shy of his 96th birthday)
